Closed fist Matt. 26:67 Roman guards

Mark 14:65 Sanhedrin

John 18:22 at the trial of Annas

John 19:3

Hitting someone is designed to hurt them

Open Fist Matt. 26:67 Roman guards

Mark 14:65 Sanhedrin

Slapping someone is designed to insult them

Reeds Matt. 27:30 Roman guards

Mark 15:19 "kept beating His head" by Roman guards

Scourging with dozens of lashes

The Jews gave 40 lashes minus 1, the Romans had no such mercy

Matt. 27:26

Mark 15:15

Nailed to a cross

Water deprivation and Hunger

Death by asphyxiation

You will never know a more brutal physical suffering than Roman crucifixion

Crown of thorns to mock His reign

Matt. 27:29

John 19:2

People Spitting on Him throughout this entire night and day

Matt. 26:67 Roman cohort

Mark 14:65 Sanhedrin

15:19 the Roman guards

AGONY

Agonizing prayer in Gethsemane

Matt. 26:42

Mark 14:33 "very distressed and troubled"

Luke 22:44 praying very fervently, sweating great drops of blood

Agonizing suffering on the Cross

Mark 15:34 My God, My God why have You forsaken Me?

This separation from His Father became His spiritual desolation

Matt. 27:45 The midday sky went completely dark.

Matt. 27:50-54 many miracles reflecting the creation groaning under the Son of God being cursed

Gal. 3:13 Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree

Isaiah 53 punctuates Christ's spiritual desolation.
