Living Worthy of the Gospel

Main passage: Philippians 1:27-30

Walk worthy of your citizenship in heaven by living only for the gospel.

1) A True Citizen of Heaven- We could never be worthy of this citizenship, but it has been purchased for us by grace. (1 Cor. 2:12, Col. 1:10, Eph. 4:1, 1 Thess. 2:12)

- Jesus didn't die to indicate how valuable we are, He died to illustrate how incapable we are and how amazing He is only.
 - Are you living your life for the gospel because Jesus is worthy or because you think you are worthy of His sacrifice?

 - What are some ways you can express your joy of being a citizen of heaven to further the gospel?

2) Worthy of the Gospel (v27) – “Only let your manner of life be worthy^{of} of the gospel of Christ”

- A. Gospel clarity: Salvation is a free gift of grace (Rom. 3:23-25)- Repentance of sin and trusting in Christ and His work on the cross
 - Gospel means “good news.” Take time to write out the gospel.
 - B. Gospel priority (Romans 1:16)
 - Are you ashamed of sharing the gospel?

 - What areas in your life do you need to make the gospel a priority? In your marriage? Parenting? At work? Around family/friends?

- C. Gospel Unity: Solo Christianity is suspicious Christianity (Proverbs 18:1)
 - Are you by God's grace humble enough to submit yourself to joining community for the sake of gospel progress?

- D. Gospel Urgency- Vigorous, striving together for gospel accomplishment
 - What is your current level of commitment to the local church body in serving? Do you need to take the next step to pursue church membership?
