Passage: Philippians

The Surpassing Value of Jesus [Phil 3:8; 2:5-11]

- 1) Glorified in His Humiliation
- 2) Glorified in His Exaltation
 - Jesus is glorified in his humiliation as he emptied himself and endured the shame on the cross. He is glorified in his exaltation as we bow the knee to honor/bless the king of surpassing value.

- 3) Salvation by Faith Alone
 - Two Fixed Truths:
 - First and most importantly, salvation is all of God and by faith alone.
 - Second, saving faith always changes our hearts and leads to obedience and following Christ
- 4) Sanctification on the Hustle – The Great Adventure of the Christian Life
 - Justification, the beginning of salvation, is by faith alone. The growth and development in our sanctification is filled with trials that we may share in his sufferings yet press on – straining forward is a Christian value.
