The Tremendous Power of God's Word

Main Passage: Psalm 19:7-9

A) Creation Reveals God's Glory Generally (Ps. 19:1-6)

[Is. 40:12-17; Rom. 1:18-20]

- God has revealed Himself in "the book" of the world- *general revelation*- truth about God's glory found in creation.
 - A. God created the world to reflect His characteristics. What attribute(s) of God do you meditate upon when you think about the work of His hands? (nature/humanity)?

 - B. Explain a time when you were out in nature, and it caused you to pause and worship the Creator.

B) The Bible Reveals God's Power Specially (Ps. 19:7-9)

[Ps. 119:50, 89, 128, 137, 138, 142, 160; Rom. 12:2; 2 Tim. 3:15, 16; Jn. 14:6; Jer. 15:16; Jn. 15:11; Lk. 11:28; Ps. 12:6; Ps. 11:7]

- You cannot be saved or know God fully by recognizing God's attributes revealed in creation (general revelation); To be saved and to know God fully, you need access to God's special revelation. This comes to us through God's Holy, written word alone- the complete authority of truth for the believer.
