- Greek for magi is *magos* (μ**άγος**): They were a monotheistic, priestly and political tribe who were astrologers and astronomers from the medo-persian empire from the 7th century B.C. who learned (being trained by Daniel) of the future coming of King Jesus by following a special, glorious star.
 - **A.** The Bible is a historically accurate book. What other literary genres of the Bible are there? Why is it important to know these genres?

B. When the Magi found the home in Bethlehem in which Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were staying, they came bearing gifts: gold (symbolizing kingship), frankincense (symbolizing priestly offering), and myrrh (symbolizing burial and sacrifice), and they fell down and worshiped Him. In what ways, do you offer your gifts to King Jesus in worship and adoration?

2) The Tyrannical Madman: Herod the Great
