The Glorious Anticipation of Jesus Christ

Main passage: Matt 1:18-25

God has written a divine book that reveals His purposeful plan throughout all of redemptive history. As we become more aware of God's plan of redemption through His Son Jesus Christ, we are led to trust & follow His Word and to worship Him.

1) A Great Man – Joseph:

- Mary was betrothed (committed) to Joseph, but their marriage had not yet been consummated when she was found with child. Joseph certainly felt betrayed in his confusion of what appeared to be fornication with another man. Joseph was a "just" and honorable man of mercy and compassion, and so he sought to quietly and privately divorce Mary. Joseph was sober minded, and after a visitation from angels, yielded to God's purposes, submitting to the will of God to remain with Mary.
- A. Describe how Joseph's response was honorable and right. _____
- B. Are you living according to the glory of the Lord? How is your life characterized by a concern with what others think of you or what God knows about you?

2) A Foundational Truth – The Virgin Birth (The Divine Conception)

- Jesus was conceived by a divine intervention in His conception through the Holy Spirit.
 - A key to interpreting Scripture narrative is through finding repetition (v18 with child from the Holy Spirit, v19 just man, v19 put her away quietly, v20 conceived by the Holy Spirit, v23 a virgin).

The virgin birth is an essential doctrine of the Christian faith:

- o To fulfill prophecy Isaiah 7:14
- o To ensure His sinlessness sin is passed down from the seed of the father, but Christ had no earthly father ((Gen 3:15; Gal 4:4).
- To authenticate His divinity Jesus and the Father are One, God true God, (John 10:30; John 8:58; John 14:9, 1 Cor 2:8).
- To explain His unique life and ministry the Person, work, and words of Jesus Christ

 To set Christ apart for a divine mission – one Man dying for the redemption of His saints and adoption as sons in Christ Jesus
